Reminder Deer Hunters:

All deer hunters will have to participate in a weapons competency demonstration shoot to be eligible to hunt deer during the 2008-2009 Season at Pleasant Hill. You will need to demonstrate your abilities with all types of weapons you intend to use on the Pleasant Hill Property this season (i.e., shotgun, muzzleloader, handgun and archery). The terms are placement of 3 out of 4 rounds on a standard paper plate at the following distances:

Shotgun and Muzzleloader: 45 yards

Handgun: 35 yards

Archery: 20 yards
