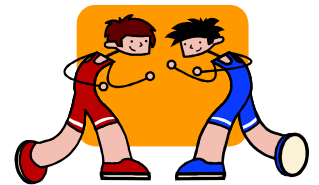

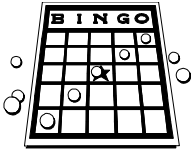

Installments not paid by the quarterly due date will incur a \$25 late fee for each month that remains unpaid up to 6 months. After 6 months, the late fee will be increased to \$50 per month. Anyone in arrears over 9 months will forfeit their trailer spot. Upon forfeiture of trailer spot, all unpaid fees (installments and late fees) are due and payable.
