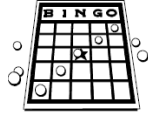

Guys of the SNY—Keepin' You Posted

Next Sny Meeting is October 6th at 7:30 PM. A Deer, Duck and/or Trailer Meeting will start at 6:30. The 3rd quarter pad fee was due no later than September 30th. Any payments received after September 30th are subject to a late fee. This fee was approved by the membership on August 19, 2008. It reads as follows: Effective 2009, a late fee of \$25 per month will be assessed after the due date for up to six months. After six months, the late fee will be \$50 per month. Anyone in arrears over 9 months will lose their permanent trailer site. All trailer pad fees must be paid in full, up to date, before December 31 for the current year.

The 2nd duck fee of \$75 is due no later than October 1st.

Deer Hunters for PH have a 3 day work obligation for 2009 season. Duck Hunters for Pleasant Hill have work assignments to be eligible for the 2009 season. All work requirements for either deer or duck hunting are posted at the Godfrey club and Pleasant Hill. Hunters may contact committee chairmen with questions. Committee Chairmen have a list of those individuals exempt from any work obligation for the 2009 season.
