## Benefit on April 30th

A benefit will be held on April 30<sup>th</sup> in the Ballroom for Gabriel Rambeau. Gabriel was born with a rare tumor that only 0.03% of the world has. At birth Gabriel was rushed to Saint Louis Children's Hospital for evaluation of a mass that was protruding from his chest. At 2 days old Gabriel endured a CT scan, which revealed 4 masses. At 2 days old he had the one removed from the top of his chest. In the next 3 months a CT scan revealed that one of the 4 tumors inside of his chest had grown to the size of a softball. To save Gabe's already crushed lung he had the tumor removed at 4 months old. During this surgery Gabriel had 4 ribs removed. By the time Gabriel was a year old he had developed progressive scoliosis and was already at a 40 Degree curve. Gabriel had also developed something called Thoracic Insufficiency Syndrome. This is a condition where his chest cavity cannot withstand normal growth. Gabe's chest cavity will actually begin to cave in on itself because of his missing ribs and progressive scoliosis. Gabriel needs to have an experimental surgery called VEPTR. Without this surgery his chest will eventually collapse in and crush his lung and heart. After Gabe has these rods placed he will need surgery every 4-6 months until he is around 16 years old to lengthen the rods as he grows. Gabriel is a very special little boy and deserves the best as any child does. Please join us to raise money for Gabriel's cause.

Gabriel is the grandson of Bobby and Pat Schneider, and the son of Laura and Randy Rambeau. There will also be raffles in the lounge prior to the benefit.

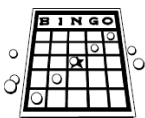
Trailer spot #53 (Ed Jenkins' spot) is now Matt Smith's spot!
