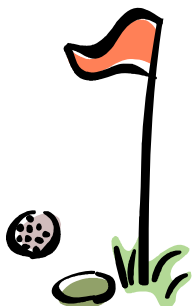

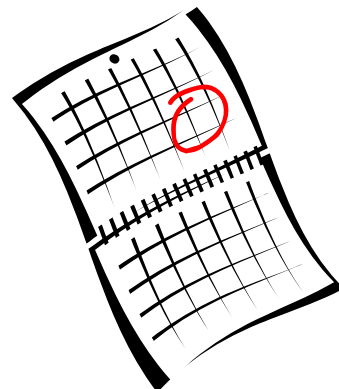

As the new Trap Chairman, I have been overwhelmed at the amount of volunteers who have lent a hand in this process. All of this will culminate on Sat, Aug 20th, for our 75 Bird Derby and Trap House Open House.
