

**Alton-Wood River Sportsmen's Club, Inc.  
House and Ground Rules, Trailer Rules**

1. No smoking on 3<sup>rd</sup> floor. Anyone caught smoking on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor will be immediately suspended from any activity on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor for one year.
2. Children under 16 years of age are not allowed on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor without parental supervision.
3. No cleaning of game in the kitchen sinks or restrooms. Body fat from game or grease is not to be left in sinks.
4. Overnight fees:  
All persons over 21 .....\$7.50 per person/per night  
**This applies to anyone staying in the clubhouse, tent, or trailer where they are not the trailer owner.**  
Trailer owners and their spouse are exempt from this fee when staying in their trailer.
5. Camp fires are to be in a fireplace or in a suitable container.
6. Members and their guests are to clean up any area of the property they use.
7. No one may leave food or game in the freezers or refrigerators when they leave the Club. Food freezer may be used by the Caretaker.
8. The 3<sup>rd</sup> floor is for sleeping. Any radio, TV, or stereo playing is to be done on a minimal noise basis so as not to disturb your neighbor.
9. Air conditioners in the Club House will charge \$1.25 per day.
10. No dogs allowed in Club House.
11. Trailer Rules:
  - A. Permanent trailer sites, which include pad fee, cot fees for the trailer owner and spouse, electrical fees are \$400 annually. This annual fee will be payable quarterly with \$100 due March 31, June 30, September 30, and December 31. Effective 2009, a

late fee of \$25 per month will be assessed after the due date for up to six months. After six months, the late fee will be \$50 per month. Anyone in arrears over 9 months will lose their permanent trailer site. All trailer pad fees must be paid in full, up to date, before December 31 for the current year.

There are three temporary trailer sites. Temporary hookups are allowed for up to 15 consecutive dates. **Pad fees for temporary hookups are \$0.50 per day, plus \$7.50 per day/per person for persons 21 years of age and older. An additional charge of \$1.25 per day will be assessed for the use of air conditioner or electric heater.**

- B. Trailers will be kept mobile at all times. (Mobile will be determined by the SNYE Committee and Trailer Chairman).
- C. No new campers may connect to a crowded electrical box.
- D. Anyone who wishes to pull his camper out of the campground and still reserve the site may do so once per year for up to 90 days upon written notice to the Trailer Committee. Pad fees will continue during the temporary absence.
- E. Any single or multiple axle camper, regardless of what style, will pay regular camper fees while on Club property.
- F. The Trailer Committee will contact all new trailer owners to see if they may want to change their pad location in the future. If so, their name will be added to the current "Move Up" list. Members wanting to get on the "Waiting List" must submit a dated request in writing to the Trailer Committee Chairman. All trailer pads that are vacated will be filled by the following procedure:

When a trailer site becomes available, the Trailer committee will announce trailer pad openings for the "Move Up" list in the Bulletin, Snye Meeting, and

Membership Meeting. Selection will be made by position on trailer "Move Up" list. The first of the following month will be the deadline to contact the Trailer Chairman. It is the responsibility of the trailer owner to contact the Trailer Chairman. The first person on the waiting list will have the first chance to claim the vacant site. If he passes, the choice will go on to the next in line, but he will maintain his position on the list. The person who is awarded the available site will have 14 days to move their trailer on to the site, or will forfeit the opportunity for said site.

- G. There will be no trading of trailer sites under any circumstances.**
- H. Major appliances, such as refrigerators, are not allowed outside unoccupied trailers.
- I. All registered trailer owners will put in 1 day of work at Pleasant Hill per year. Work to be done will be posted on the bulletin board by the Grounds Chairman, House Chairman, and Trailer Chairman. Members may choose the work best suited to his or her abilities and capabilities. On completion of work day, he or she will sign his or her name on his or her page of a book provided, with date and work performed. Workdays must be completed by December 1. Failure to comply would be loss of his trailer spot as of December 1, and he would go to the bottom of the trailer waiting list. This rule has nothing to do with duck and deer work days.
- J. Storage of campers and unregistered watercraft at Pleasant Hill is prohibited.**
- K. All site improvements must be referred to the Trailer Committee. In addition, the Trailer Committee has the authority to designate a trailer's position on a trailer site.
- L. If the Trailer Chairman does not have a permanent site, the Snye Committee will designate site for the Trailer Chairman. After 3 years of service as Trailer

Chairman, the site becomes the permanent site of said Trailer Chairman. If Trailer Chairman relinquishes his role prior to the end of 3 years and has not been awarded a permanent site from the Waiting List, the trailer site becomes available to the "Move Up" list rules.

12. All guns brought into the Club House must be encased or disassembled.
13. It is recommended that any personal property of Club members left on Club grounds is left at their own risk, and the Club is not liable for same.
14. No rifle or pistol shooting except birdshot or while deer hunting during designated deer seasons in compliance with state regulations.
15. The discharge of firearms or bow and arrow within 100 yards radius of Club House is prohibited. This includes BB guns, air rifles, and slingshots.
16. Only Club members are allowed to use the Levee Road and boat launching facilities.
- 17. Idle speed only around Clubhouse. This applies to all vehicles. Also, all vehicles are prohibited from the walkway between the clubhouse and the campground. **Parking between the Clubhouse and Pavilion is prohibited unless unloading or loading your vehicle, this includes ATV's.****
18. Turkey hunting will be allowed on the property during the spring gun season, the fall gun season, and fall bow season. If more than 1 hunter hunts on any day during gun season, they will draw for areas using the rules for shotgun deer hunting. Bow hunters will abide by the archery deer hunting rules. All hunters must have the proper Illinois permits and be at least a Regular member.
19. The riding mower will be used by the Caretaker only.
20. There will be no vehicles allowed in the ABC area except for work details. No ATV's allowed on the suspended bridge in the Lower Area. ATV's are allowed on the refuge levee only for

work details. The trail from #16 deer stand to #6 duck blind is closed to all traffic except work details, retrieving a downed deer, and waterfowl hunting.

21. Joy riding will be restricted as follows:
  - A. There will be no joy riding in the bottoms during hunting hours during any firearm deer season.
  - B. ATV riding will be restricted to the established trails at all times – except for work parties or when retrieving a deer.
  - C. During the spring firearm turkey season, joy riding in the bottoms will be prohibited from 2:00 a.m. til 9:00 a.m.
  - D. From the opening day of deer bow season until the opening day of duck season, joy riding in the bottoms will be prohibited from 2:00 a.m. till 9:00 a.m. During duck season, joy riding in the bottoms will be prohibited from 2:00 a.m. till 10;00 a.m.

Definitions –

Bottoms: Timbered land bordered by the Snye ditch on the north, the river levee on the south, and the entrance road on the west.

Joy riding: Any RV riding not related to hunting, fishing, or spring mushroom hunting.

ATV riding in the bottoms is prohibited from October 23 until the start of duck season, except to retrieve a downed deer.

22. No other hunting, other than duck and deer hunting, on Club property during shotgun deer season.
23. There is a 3 bag limit or equivalent of ice when leaving Club grounds.
24. Juniors under 18 will not be allowed to stay overnight in the clubhouse without parent or guardian.
25. No hunting of any kind in the refuge or within 10 yards of the center of the levee.

26. All guests and Junior members visiting the Pleasant Hill grounds must be accompanied by an adult member; that member is responsible for sponsored guests and Junior members.
27. The former target shooting area by the dumpster is no longer in use.
28. During the one day prior to the November firearm deer season and one day prior to December firearm deer season, all foot and ATV traffic (except for traffic related to waterfowl hunting) is prohibited in the bottoms.
29. All members are to sign the register for themselves and their guests anytime they visit the property.
30. Firearm practice shooting will be allowed only from noon to 2:00 p.m. during duck season.
31. During the spring turkey season, all persons in the woods other than turkey hunters must wear blaze orange clothing until noon.
